DOE has been conducting weekly monitoring for methane gas at the airport landfill since methane was detected at several spinners at 100% of LEL in 2013. NMED has been receiving weekly monitoring results electronically and monthly reports through office mail. The results indicate that methane is consistently detected at some of the spinners at 100% LEL. The methane detections have been relatively consistent over time. NMED is aware that DOE is proposing to fix the problem by replacing the existing MATCON cover which has not performed as expected. Therefore, NMED is recommending that DOE reduce the methane monitoring frequency to once a month and report these results to NMED on quarterly basis.

NMED may increase the frequency in future depending on the monitoring results. Call me if you need further clarification.
